General Dynamics Bath Iron Works Awarded \$40 Million Navy Contract

BATH, Maine – The U.S. Navy has awarded General Dynamics Bath Iron Works a \$40 million modification to a previously awarded contract for DDG 51 and FFG 7 Class planning yard services. Work will be performed in Bath, Maine, and is expected to be completed by September 2004. Bath Iron Works provides engineering and design services and logistics support for maintenance, modernization and repair of DDG 51 and FFG 7 Class ships.
